The Flagler County School District has aligned the Student Progression Plan and promotion and retention procedures with the Florida State Statutes. In all grades, students are evaluated to determine the appropriateness of promotion or retention based on progress tests, classroom assignments, daily observations, district and state assessments, mastery of Course Performance Standards, district competencies and objectives. Social promotion is not a factor for retention or promotion. In addition, third grade students must demonstrate a proficiency in reading by attaining a score of Level 2 or higher on the Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) in order to be promoted to the fourth grade.
