

**Overview:** Each year, the assessment office receives a series of comprehensive files that show how each grade level and core subject area are performing on state tests (FSA & FCAT). This analysis is in addition to the initial analysis completed which usually only looks at whether or not a grade level is above or below state averages. The benefit of this analysis is that it puts into perspective how each grade level and subject rank amongst the 67 school districts throughout the state.
