**WHEREAS, Florida's educational leaders are providing opportunities for fathers to engage more fully in their child's education and strengthen the connections between fathers and schools; and**


**WHEREAS, Florida Department of Education staff members are available to provide information, resources, and training to support families and educators in using school and state performance data, making informed school choice decisions, and establishing effective home-school collaborations so that families can be actively involved in the academic achievement and development of students; and**

**WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the critical contributions made by fathers who foster a love for learning in their children and by educators who acknowledge the importance of family engagement and encourage participation by fathers as an integral part of the mission of all schools;**
