Playing Assignment Grading Rubric

- The student attempted to play the exercise but it is unrecognizable. Exercise may not have been completed. Posture may or may not be correct. (50%)
- 2 Key signature is missed often, tempo is not steady, *tone quality is poor*. Articulation is incorrect. Posture is inconsistent. **Percussion:** Hand position is incorrect. Stick heights are inconsistent. (65%)
- Key signature is missed at times, tempo may or may not be steady, *tone quality is inconsistent*, articulation is inconsistent. Posture is correct. Percussion: Hand position may or may not be correct. Stick heights are inconsistent. (75%)
- 4 Understands the key signature and almost all notes are correct. Tempo is steady, *tone is good*, articulation is inconsistent. Posture is correct. **Percussion:** Hand position is correct. Stick heights are consistent. (85%)
- 4.5 Same as level 5, but with a slight deviation in one aspect. (90%)
- Key signature is NEVER missed. All notes are correct. Tempo is steady, *tone quality is characteristic*, articulation is well developed. Excellent posture. The exercise finishes musically. **Percussion:** Hand position is correct. Stick heights are consistent. (100%)
- All aspects of a level 5, but scale is performed from memory. Scales only. (110%)
