

**Description of Flagler/Palm Coast Kiwanis Club Foundation Scholarships**  
Year 2012 Graduates

Flagler/Palm Coast Kiwanis Foundation Scholarship. (4 nominees, two from each High School. One \$8,000 Scholarship over 4 yr period and Three \$1,000 Scholarship to the three remaining finalist)

This is a competitive scholarship to attend a college in the Florida University System for which interested students are required to complete a separate application. Each school selects two finalists which are then interviewed by the Kiwanis Scholarship Committee. The final selection is based upon Academic Standing, Teacher recommendations, Essay and the Kiwanis Scholarship committee interview. The scholarship is awarded over a 4 year period. The remaining finalist are awarded Kiwanis Foundation Book Scholarships.

Robert Osner Kiwanis Scholarship. (Two \$2,500, 1 for each High School)

The Robert Osner Scholarships are given in Memory of Robert Osner, a World War II Veteran and member of the Flagler/Palm Coast Kiwanis Club for over 30 years. Mr. Osner was designated as Mr. Kiwanian for his dedication to Kiwanis and service to the Children of Flagler County. Two Scholarships are awarded to students, identified by the Guidance Dept of each school, who have demonstrated a determination to succeed, have a financial need, and will be attending a College or University within Florida.
