


NAVY ROTC \$180,000

- High School Senior, Junior in your second semester of high school or college student with less than 30 college credit hours.
- ✓ MinimumACT Scores: Math 21 & Verbal 22 or
- ✓ Minimum SAT Scores: Math 520 & Verbal 530
- ✓ Not open to Active Duty Service Members
- ✓ Not open to Drilling Navy Reservists
