

WINGS OVER FLAGLER William "Wild Bill" Walker Memorial Scholarship

Was established in 2009 and rededicated in 2010 to honor and celebrate the life of William "Wild Bill" Walker who was tragically lost at the 2010 Wings Over Flagler Airshow. Bill Walker wasn't just a great pilot in the air; he was truly a great pilot in life. He was a man who possessed "the right stuff". MAC is dedicated to inspiring our next generation of aviation enthusiast; assist them in following their aviation dreams and help "bring aviation to life"!

The Wings Over Flagler William "Wild Bill" Walker Memorial Scholarship assists and rewards students who have a love of aviation and have demonstrated academic potential, leadership, and extracurricular involvement. All students in good academic standing and plan to continue their education by entering any college or university are eligible for these scholarships. Applicants pursuing an academic degree directly associated with aviation or aerospace will receive priority. The degree of association will be one of the selecting factors.

The Wings Over Flagler Scholarship Committee is pleased to announce that for 2011-2012 we will be awarding up to \$5,000 in scholarships.

Eligibility and Requirements

- The applicant's legal residence must be in Flagler County, Florida. A photocopy of a Florida Driver's License or other proof of residence must be included with the application.
- The applicant must have a grade point average of not less than 3.0.
- The applicant must be currently planning to enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours (full time) each semester during the year of the awarded scholarship.
- The applicant's academic course work shall be such as to provide entry into some career field that is associated with aviation or aerospace. Applicants pursuing an academic degree directly associated with aviation, aeronautics, or aerospace will receive priority; the degree of association will be one of the selecting factors.
- Students who receive an award are eligible to reapply in succeeding years. It should be stressed that renewal is not automatic. To apply for a renewal, an individual must complete a new application.
- Applicants must be either citizens or permanent residents of the United States.

A. SELECTION CRITERIA

The recipients of the scholarship awards will be selected using the following criteria, which are listed in order of importance.

1. **ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE:** This criterion will be evaluated on the basis of each applicant's grade point average or equivalent. A grade point average of at least 3.0 (B) is required.
2. **PERSONAL INTERVIEW:** The Scholarship Committee may schedule a personal interview to evaluate career objectives of the applicant, how the applicant plans to achieve those career objectives and how the career objectives are associated with aviation or aerospace.
3. **RECOMMENDATION:** Each applicant will be judged on personal and academic merit, based on the three required letters of recommendation
4. **EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:** Each applicant's participation in high school and community activities, organizational offices held, awards, and work experience will receive due consideration.
5. **FINANCIAL NEED:** Determination of financial need is primarily based on three factors: a. gross income listed; b. number of family members in the home; and c. number of family members in college.

B. APPLICATION PROCESS

Each applicant is required to provide the following information:

1. A completed application form including Resume.
2. A photocopy of the applicant's valid driver's license or other official I.D. showing legal place of residence*.
3. Three (3) typewritten letters of recommendation. Past WOF scholarship recipients applying for a renewal of their scholarship must provide two (2) recommendation letters. Recommendations from relatives of applicants will not be accepted.

C. DISBURSEMENTS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Disbursement shall be made by means of a fund transfer or check from the Flagler County Education Foundation to the credit of the recipient at his or her educational institution. Formal award letters will be mailed to the selected recipients and to their educational institutions.
