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Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Our middle and high schools in Flagler County offer valuable and cost-saving opportunities for our students to bridge education to the workforce through our Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs. The opportunity to earn industry certification is a voluntary process, offered free of charge by Flagler Schools. Industry certifications earned by high school students articulate for postsecondary credits. The certifications earned are beneficial to our Flagler Schools students as they enter the workforce and become more competitive in the marketplace.

Students earning an industry certification with a state-wide articulation agreement shall be eligible to receive the cost savings shown in the attached table. In order to receive the associated cost savings and the established articulation credit, a student shall be enrolled in the associated AS Program of Articulation that is offered at a Florida postsecondary institution.

- Students who earn a recognized industry certification become eligible for the Merit Designation on their high school diploma upon graduation.
- Students who remain in a Career and Technical program of study and earn a minimum of three high school credits in that program will have successfully completed one requirement associated with Florida's Bright Future Gold Seal Scholarship.
