**Statement of Non-Discrimination Policy
(Annual Notification of Nondiscrimination for Vocational Programs)**

This annual reminder is being provided in compliance with State and Federal Civil Rights Laws concerning public notification of said laws. The School District of Flagler County offers more than 20 career and technical education (CTE) programs at the secondary level. The School District of Flagler County prohibits discrimination in the terms and conditions of employment, and in access to educational programs and activities, and prohibits harassment of any individual or group on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, age, disability, marital status, sexual orientation or genetic information (and other protected classes included in the district's nondiscrimination policies).
